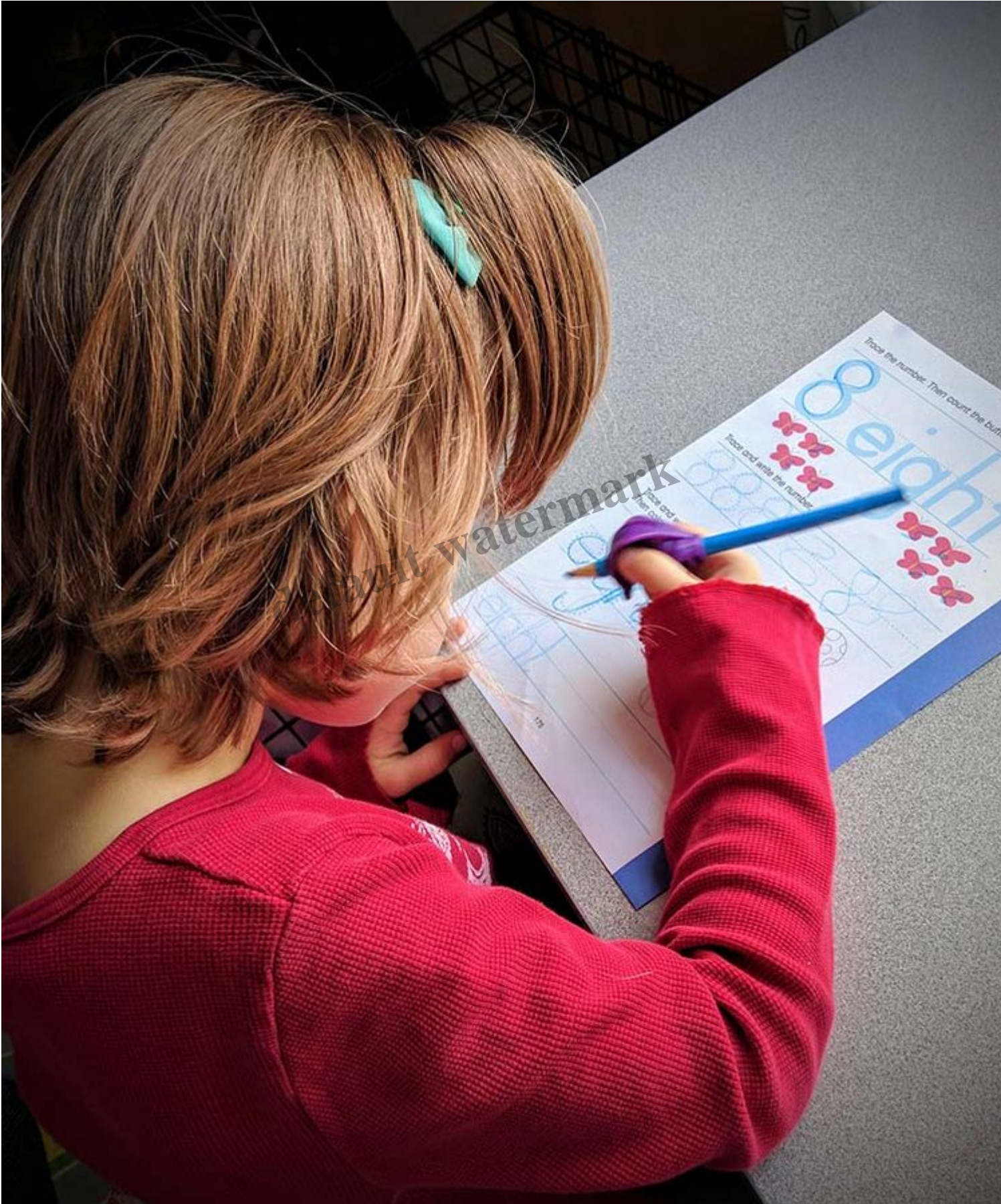
## Signature practices

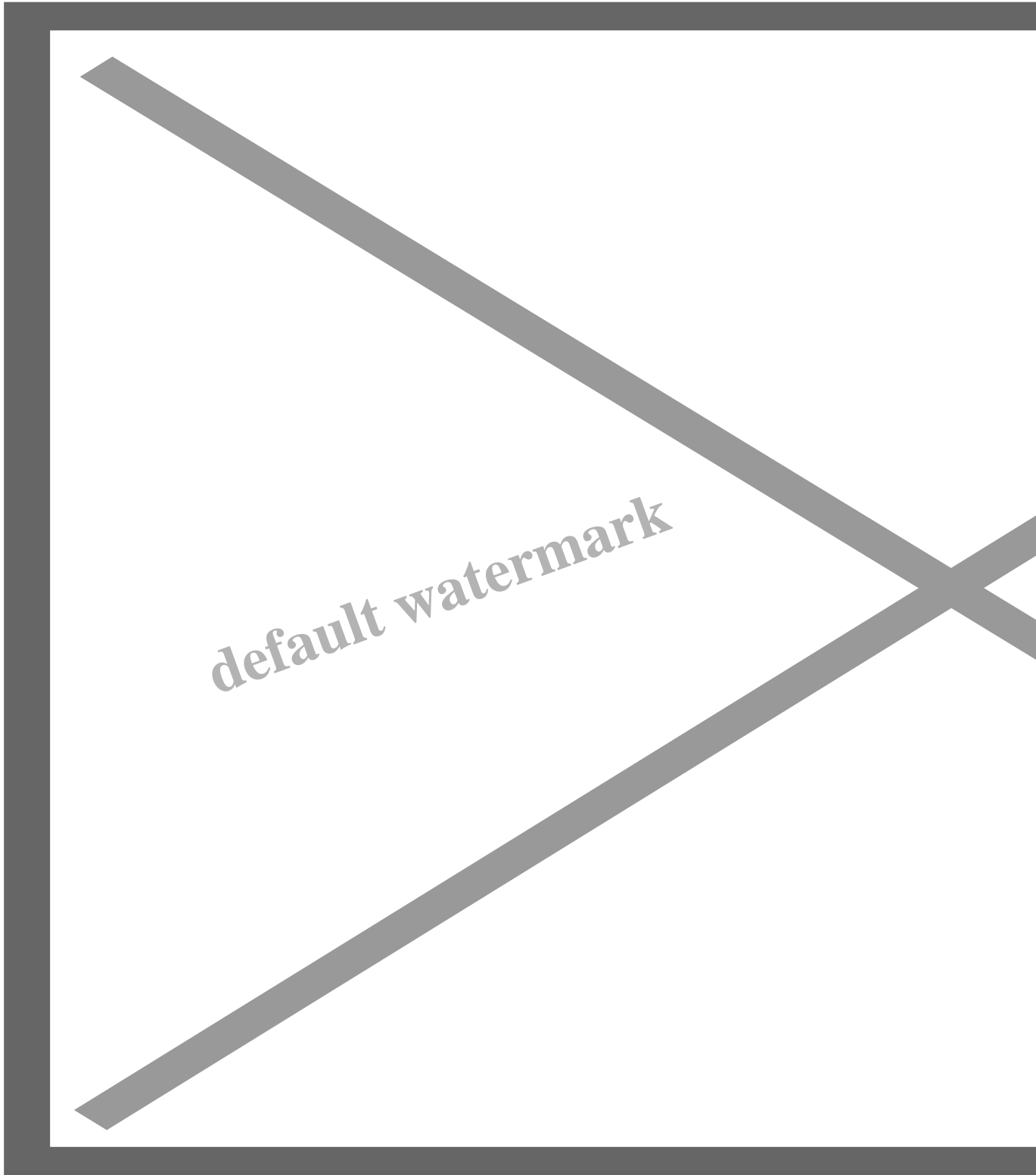
